

How much ethnic heritage must I have to run for Miss Czech-Slovak WI State Queen or participate in the Miss Czech-Slovak WI State Queen Pageant?



Queen Candidates and Jr. Royalty:

There is no minimum percentage of Czech, Slovak, Moravian, Silesian, or Rusyn heritage that you must have in order to run for Miss Czech-Slovak WI State Queen or as a Junior Royalty member. Each generation has a smaller percentage of Czech-Slovak blood than the generation before. What you must be able to do is trace your roots back to the Czech-Slovak homelands. This is where the creation of your family tree comes in and becomes a vital piece of your application.

If you are adopted, you do not personally have to have Czech-Slovak heritage as you may trace it through your adoptive parents. We have had crowned royalty in the past that can only prove their Czech-Slovak heritage via their adopted family.

Little Siblings: Little Siblings do not need to have any Czech-Slovak heritage in order to participate in the Miss Czech-Slovak WI State Queen Pageant.
